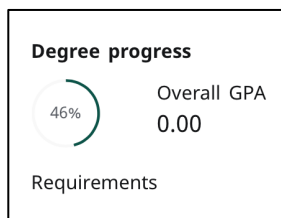
**Concentration(s):** Displays the student's current concentration(s) (if applicable).

**Access ID:** Alternative ID (other than Banner ID) tied to a student's record.

**Advisor:** A designated Staff/Faculty member whom students can consult in order to address professional, enrollment, and academic interests. Displays the student's advisor(s).



**Degree Progress Circle:** This circle estimates your how close you are to earning your degree, considering the complete and incomplete requirements throughout your audit. This area also shows your Overall GPA.
