***Art Studio: 2D/3D/Drawing** - For Art majors with a score of 3, 4, 5 - contact the Art Department for portfolio review.

***English Literature or Language/Composition** - Credits will be awarded for either examination, but not for both.

***Calculus AB/BC** - A score of 2 to 5 satisfies the Quantitative Experience (QE) General Education requirement. A score of 2, however, is not awarded credit.

***Physics C: Mechanics & E&M** - No equivalent credit is granted for score of 3.

***Precalculus** - A score of 3 to 5 satisfies the Quantitative Experience (QE) General Education requirement. A score of 3, however, is not awarded credit.

Wayne State University General Education Requirements:

All WSU students fulfill the university's general education requirements, which are classes in addition to courses within the students' major that ensure fundamental skills and a well-rounded education. These are as follows:
